Arthur Alber was born in Birmingham. Alabama where he resided and attended the local public schools until he was fifteen years old.

Together with his parents he removed to Los Angeles, California in 1907 where he graduated from Hollywood High School and in 1918 received his degree of Doctor of Jurisprudence from University of Southern California.

Mr. Alber served in the Army at Vancouver, Washington where he attended officers training school. After the Armistice he returned to Los Angeles where on March 1, 1919 he was admitted to the California Bar, and since that date has been engaged in the private practice of Law.

On July 1, 1925 Mr. Alber was elected to the City Council from the 2nd Councilmanic District. He served one two-year term and was not a candidate for reelection.
