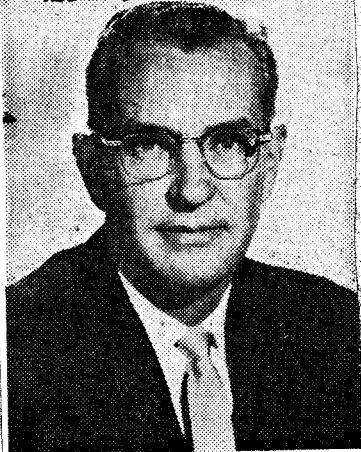


Lemoine Blanchard

Councilman Lemoine Blanchard, Second District, has spent 49 of his 50 years as a resident of the San Fernando Valley. He was educated in local schools and joined his father's lumber company soon after graduation.

Councilman Blanchard was the only non-incumbent elected to the City Council in 1959.

Active in the youth field, he has been a member of the board of management of both North Hollywood and Studio YMCA's for 20 years.

Blanchard has acted as chairman of the fund-raising committee and as president and chairman of the initial gifts campaigns of the YMCA. He served as a Cub Scout leader for two years.

In addition to his reputation as a successful businessman, Blanchard has built an outstanding record of civic service and community leadership.

He was a founding member and president of the junior chamber of commerce in his community at 24. He has also served as vice president of the senior chamber.

Active in Community Chest, Red Cross, March of Dimes, Heart Association, and the Cancer Fund, Blanchard was on the committee that organized civil defense in the San Fernando Valley.

He was a member of the Los Angeles County Housing Authority for 15 years until taking his Council seat, and was chairman for five years.
