L.A. can't survive four more years of decline

And because Mike Woo is losing the war against crime

In Mike Woo's Los Angeles, more people die from gunfire than car accidents. No city puts fewer police per capita on the streets. And while gangs roam our streets by the thousands, no more than 350 patrol cars are there to protect us at any one time.

How can Mike Woo stop crime, when he presided over the reduction of 700 officers from the LAPD in the last 3 years? And how does he plan to get tough, if his only response to killings in our schools is to threaten the gun-toting punks in classrooms with—a warning?

Instead of giving us a plan to fight crime, Woo irresponsibly exploits the police department by using unauthorized photographs of the chief of police in his campaign ads. But if a picture's worth a thousand words, only one word is needed to describe an L.A. with Mike Woo as Mayor—AFRAID.

Because Mike Woo let the economy fail

Mike Woo's TV commercials promise us more jobs and new life for L.A.'s economy. But what has Woo done since 1985 in City Hall...except let the economy fail?

Woo bases his revitalization plans on capital infusions to the inner-city from Asian banks. But Cathay Bank, in which he recently held stock and his family helps run, wouldn't make one home loan to an African-American in the last two years.

And Woo's own council district, Hollywood, remains a sad symbol of L.A.'s decline. Over 40 businesses on or near Hollywood Blvd. have closed their doors since 1985. And it's still an area plagued with sleaze, graffiti, gangs and crime.

Woo says he's proud of the "change" on Hollywood Blvd. since he was elected. But if that's any example, will we be "proud" of the changes to our neighborhoods—if he becomes Mayor of L.A.?

Because Mike Woo created our \$500 million deficit

hen Mike Woo campaigned in 1985, he attacked waste in City Hall. But since then, he's been one of L.A.'s worst spending offenders. His mismanagement on the City Council has put L.A. in its worst fiscal crisis in history.

This hasn't stopped Woo from voting himself a \$40,000 payraise, even though L.A. Councilmembers are among the highest paid in the country. Or spending \$280,000 to redecorate his office—and install a \$12,000 private toilet when a public men's room was just one door down the hall.

Today, instead of taking responsibility for our fiscal crisis, he spends \$500,000 of taxpayer money for his own political campaign—using our money to finance TV ads that once again promise he'll make L.A. change.
