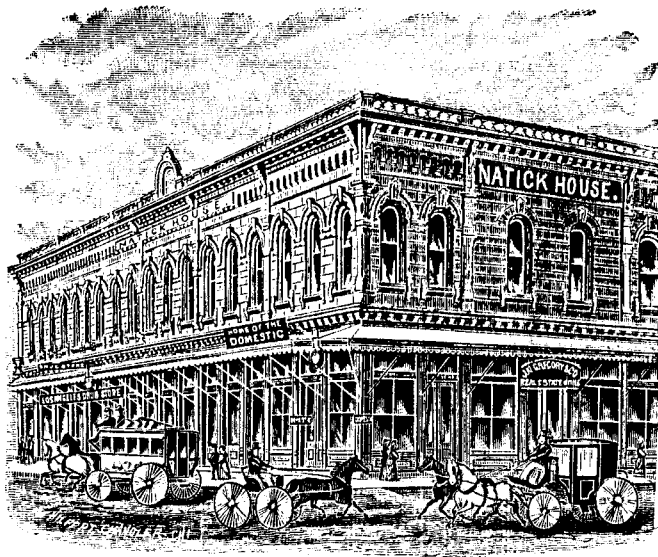


# NATICK HOUSE

It is the most centrally located house in the city; it is opposite the Grand Opera House, only half a block from the Post-office, Telegraph and Telephone Offices, and but one block from the City Hall. It has eighty large and airy rooms, with a large dining room on the first floor, with a capacity for seating 125 GUESTS. The tables are served by lady waiters.
