Biography of

COUNCILMAN MARVIN BRAUDE

Born August 11, 1920, in Chicago, Illinois, only son of Benjamin and Rose Braude. Educated in Chicago public schools; admitted to the University of Illinois in 1937 before graduation from high school; graduated from the University of Chicago in 1941 with a bachelor's degree in political science. Research assistant for Cowles Commission for Research in Economics 1941. Instructor in social science at the University of Chicago 1942. From 1942 to 1965, engaged in private business as owner and director of several successful business enterprises; founded Capital for Small Business in Los Angeles in 1959. Elected Los Angeles City Councilman in 11th District in May, 1965. Married Marjorie Sperry of Chicago on September 26, 1948. Mrs. Braude was graduated from the University of Chicago Medical School (M.D.) in 1949 and interned at the University of Illinois Research Hospital, Chicago. She was licensed to practice medicine in California in 1952. Mr. and Mrs. Braude have two daughters; Liza, born May 29, 1953, in Los Angeles; and Ann, born July 4, 1955, in Los Angeles. The Braudes have lived in Brentwood in the 11th Council District since 1952.

Braude was elected to the Los Angeles City Council in 1965 and re-elected in 1969 without opposition. He is chairman of the Council's Finance Committee and a member of the Planning and State, County & Federal Affairs Committees. He also serves on the Council's Public Works Priority Committee and the Board of Referred Powers.

The 11th Council District, which Braude represents, comprises Pacific Palisades, Brentwood, and West Los Angeles together with sections of Tarzana, Encino, Rancho Park, Westdale, Mar Vista and Venice. The district covers some 52 square miles and includes approximately 210,000 residents.

A lifelong conservationist, Braude was co-founder and first president of the Santa Monica Mountains Regional Park Association which first proposed a large park in the Santa Monica Mountains.

Prior to his election to the City Council, Braude was active in many community organizations and served as president of the Crestwood Hills Association.
