Fifteenth district Franklin P. Buyer

Member of City Council 1933-May 2, 1939

Franklin Buyer was born in Edgewood, Illinois on October 23, 1878 and was educated in public schools of the same state.

Mr. Buyer's career was as a traveling salesman throughout various parts of the country. He became a resident of California in 1920.

A democrat and a member of the Roosevelt Club #2, Mr. Buyer represented the Fifteenth district on City Council for three consecutive terms.
