Grandfather, Major-General Abram, served as first Colonel of the New York Seventh Regiment, raising and equipping the Duryee Zouaves, those colorful troops now historically famous. Father, Jacob Duryee, was the youngest commissioned Brigadier-General in the Civil war, serv ing with the Second Maryland Contingent, for the Union, which was raised by Lincoln in Baltimore.
