Councilman Harold Harby was born in Gjøvik, Norway, September 8, 1894, and attended schools in that country.

Prior to becoming a member of the Los Angeles City Council in 1939, Harby was associated with the oil industry, working at various times for the Shell Oil Company, Pacific Western Oil company and Richfield Oil corporation.

Councilman Harby is married and has two sons, Harold, 30, and Thornton, 28. Harold was a lieutenant in the Air Forces during World War II, serving as a co-pilot on a B-29. Thornton served as a private first class with the Marine Corps, and was assigned as a combat artist with the Sixth Marine Corps.

Harby is a member of BPOE #906, Santa Monica; La Cienega Home Owners association, Palms Chamber of Commerce, and the Sons of Norway. His hobbies are golf and skiing.
