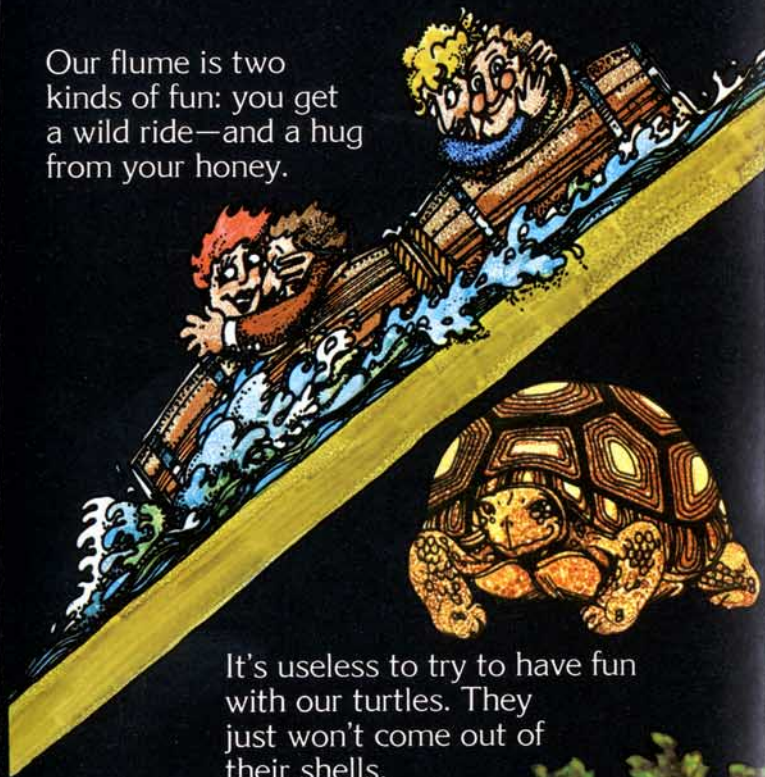


Our star cockatoo's idea of fun is having a blast every day.

Our flume is two kinds of fun: you get a wild ride—and a hug from your honey.

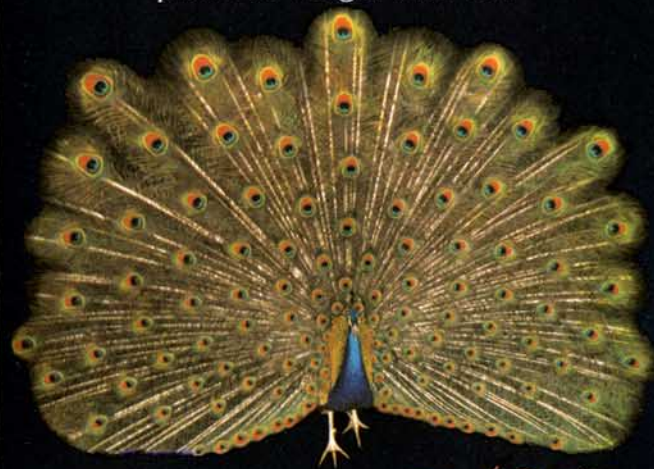


It's useless to try to have fun with our turtles. They just won't come out of their shells.

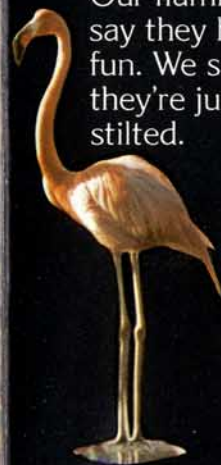
Our magician is famous for fun. In fact, his assistant thinks he's a real cutup.

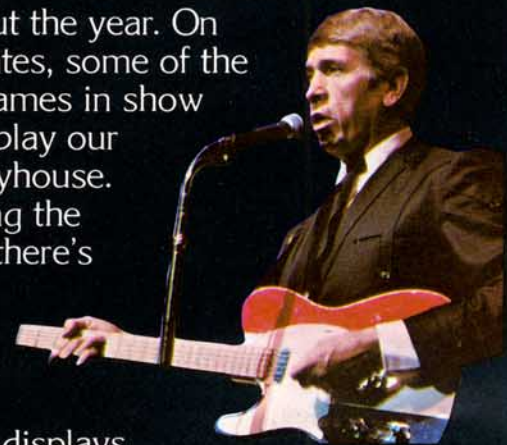

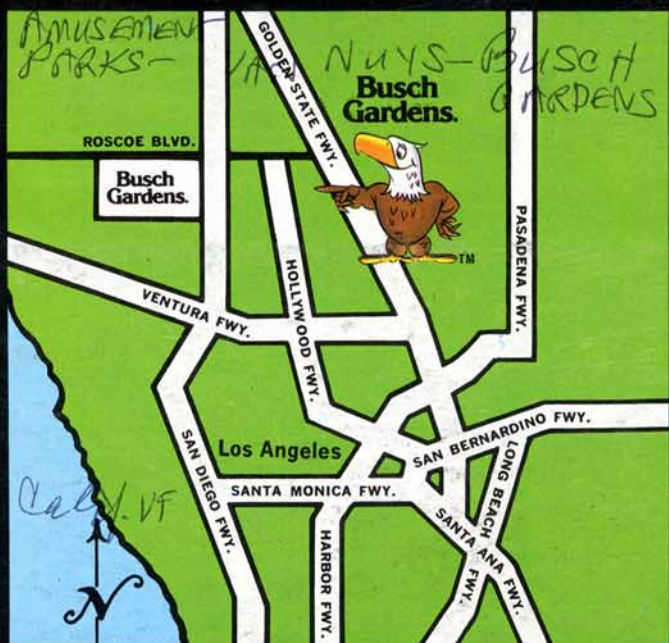
