

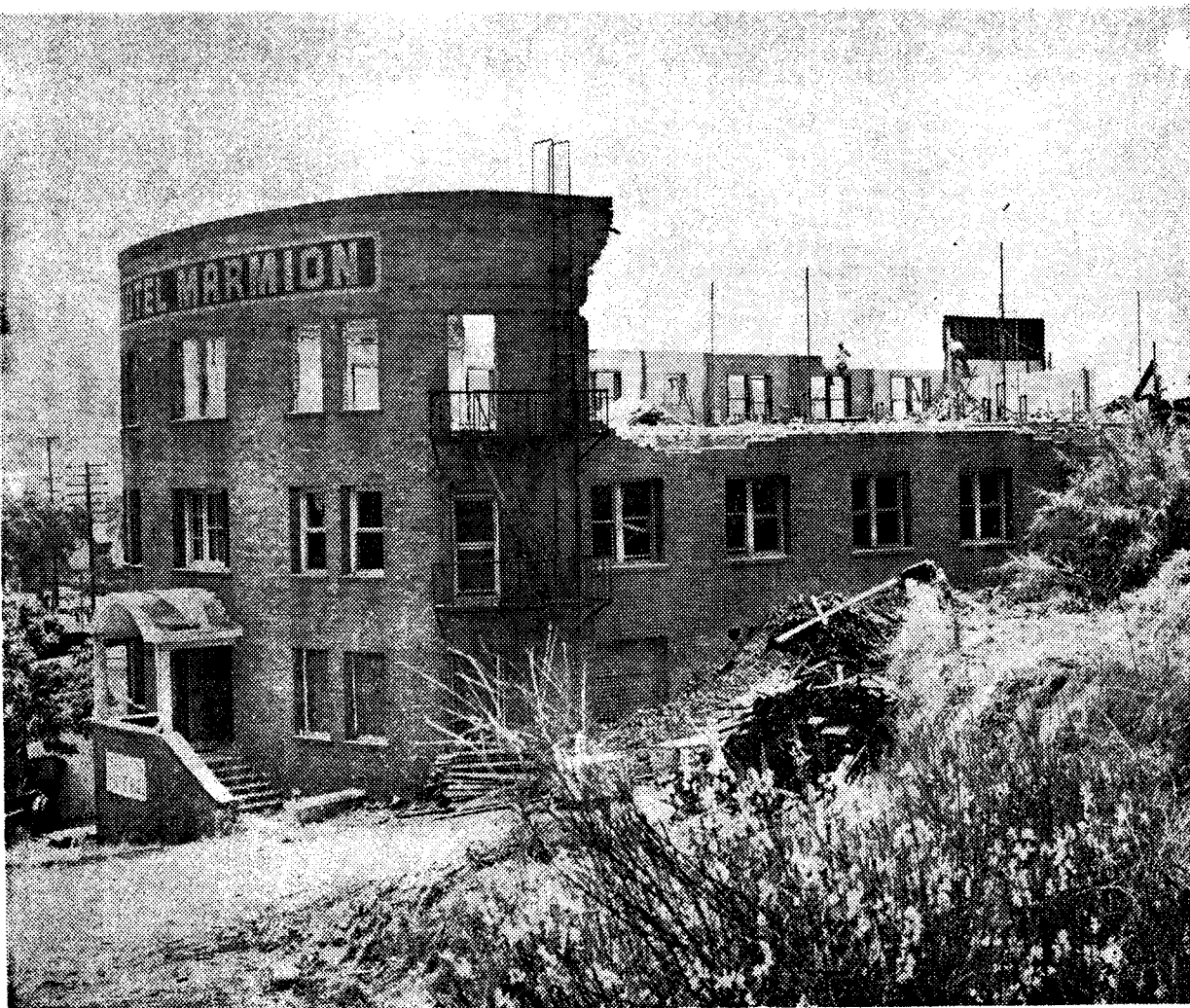

End of a landmark

More than 21 miles of bricks, if laid end to end, are contained in the Marmion Hotel now being demolished in Way near the intersection of N. Figueroa St. and Pasadena Ave. where it has been a landmark since 1914. The site will be cleared in approximately one month, according to Don Woodward, chief of the investigation division of the department of building and safety. Woodward's department ordered the demolition. Costs of razing the four-story structure will be paid by the estate of the hotel's owner, Mrs. Hilda Foote. More than 150,000 bricks will be recovered during demolition and hauled to Bakersfield where they will be sold for construction of homes and businesses.
