During 1892-93 he was Grand Master of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows of the State of California.

He was elected from the first ward, under Mayor Frank Rader, to the City Council, and served 1895-1896.

July 1, 1910 Mr. Stockwell was appointed to the Fire Commission, and served as a member of this board until July 1, 1913.

Mr. Stockwell retired in 1912 from the retail grocery business after having been engaged in it since 1885. He resides in the southside of the city.
