And - the show is ever changing, featuring a galaxy of comedians, singers, dancers and variety acts. Everyone joins in with the performers and the magical feeling of live theatre is recreated for the evening.

Eat at The Theatre

A truly unique restaurant in the beach area is *The Crystal Palace Pavilion*. The restaurant is located upstairs in the Mayfair Music Hall and is filled with theatrical lore. The walls are lined with old playbills and posters. Personal memorabilia of great English and American variety stars provide nostalgia for some and new discoveries for others. Although primarily designed to cater to the patrons of the music hall shows in the theatre proper, (there is a discount on the ticket price if combined with the dinner check), the *Crystal Palace Pavilion* provides full food service from 6:30 pm until 10:30 pm Wednesday through Sunday. Complete dinners start at reasonable prices. Full cocktail service is available. MasterCard, BankAmericard and American Express are accepted.

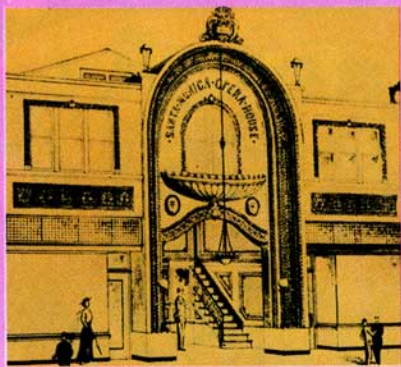
After dinner you are welcome to join in our "Afterglow" at no additional charge. (The theatre patrons and the performers have fun around the piano in the lobby after the show.)

Mayfair Music Hall and Palace of Varieties

Another Milt Larsen enterprise in Southern California (Larsen is known for his Magic Castle magician's private club in Hollywood) is the *Mayfair Music Hall and Palace of Varieties* which is located in nearby Santa Monica. It is a marvelous theatre that has been perfectly restored to a turn-of-the-century warm and charming elegance reminiscent of Victorian London of the 1880's.

The Music Hall complex also includes a complete restaurant, *The Crystal Palace Pavilion*, and an old pub brought over from Scotland many years ago, which provides wines, beers, and hearty snacks for those not wishing a complete dinner. The evening can be a total experience if you wish to make it so... cocktails in the grande promenade (the lobby bar); dinner in the fun atmosphere of the *Crystal Palace*; and then on to your very special reserved seats in the old *Music Hall*.

Oldest Operating Legitimate Theatre in Southern California

One of Southern California's oldest, still existing theatres, the *Mayfair* dates back to 1911 when it was constructed as the Santa Monica Opera House.

In the early twenties, as the Majestic Theatre, it was playing silent pictures with a pipe organ. When "talkies" came in, the organ went out and the house became a popular movie palace.

Now, lovingly restored to an Edwardian elegance complete with red velvet, gold leaf, polished brass and crystal, the *Mayfair Music Hall* has entered a new renaissance. It has been seen on many television shows and motion pictures including *Young Frankenstein*, *Harry and Walter Go to New York*, *The Rockford Files* and *Al Capone*.

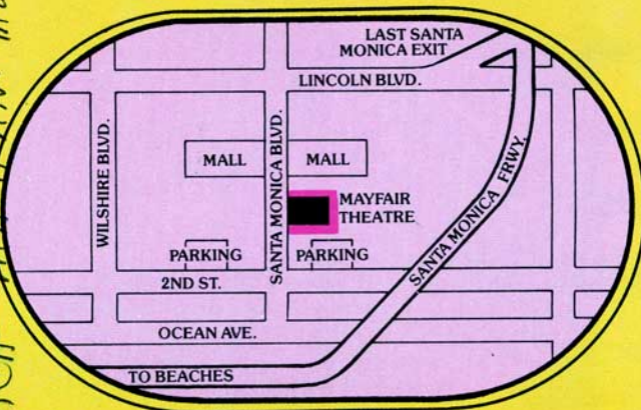
